# SRCS Santa Rosa French American Charter School Foundation Parent Association Foundation Meeting Minutes

V. Consent Agenda and Approval of Minutes

Minutes from previous meeting were approved via email and posted to the website/app. Ben motioned to approve the meeting Agenda; Monique seconded; Motion approved unanimously.
VI. Board Reports
A. PRESIDENT'S REPORT: Ben - First meeting on campus since Covid; Action: need another speaker for other end of table. EEBBER was a good turn out and great weather. Also, a good bump in kicking off Family Giving campaign and in getting some new volunteers. Currently at $30 \%$ of goal so far for Family Giving, expect more after BTS night tomorrow, so keep it coming and get the word out. Also, we're up to 14 PAFers, maybe 15 (?), so fullest PAF has been since before Covid. Bond updates: meeting tomorrow and another in November. Still researching endowments etc for annual surplus (to get more than $.02 \%$ interest), update: endowment is NOT the right path (too restrictive) but an Investment Account may be.
B. PRINCIPAL'S REPORT: Evelyn - EEBBER was a great kick off. School off to a great start. Facility Masterplan update details will be presented next week, and community input opportunities will be forthcoming. Details will be shared once known. At a special board meeting over the summer a potential option of moving SRFACS to a new location was presented, it is still in the very early stages of discussion, if it does change, it won't be a quick change - likely several years out. BTSN is tomorrow night; many resources will be
present, Info fair, ELAC meeting, Uniform Swap, etc. First Walk n Roll today was successful: 21 bikes.
C. TREASURER'S REPORT: Sean - around 158 k in general funds, 208 k in total assets. EEBBER had more food expenses, but we sold more so will likely pull through - magic show also increased in cost.

a. How to have La Plume translated to Spanish when sent out? - Aimee looking into services for non-profits, spec. Smore for educational orgs. Also need a native speaker to always review. The district has opening for Full-time Family Engagement Coordinator that could translate. Currently have only ~170 parents have opted in for La Plume, a very small part of our population. Will also work towards a more consistent schedule for distribution, as well as evaluating if needed with other communication sources. Will need bio's and headshots of new PAFers to add to website.

H. Outreach (new teacher, intern, new family welcome): Brittany, Emmanuel - no update.
I. Enrichment: Juliette
a. Fall: Starts September 18. Piano and a $2^{\text {nd }}$ Chess started today, but outside of Enrichment. Will work on getting those external ones to message more broadly too. Will use Six Crickets again. New teachers may offer new interests, and some may not be offered so may have an interesting mix. May extend time 15 mins so will run 3:15 - 4:30. May also add a specific offering for childcare students that is later in the day and also an offsite Tennis class. Hoping to get schedule out Friday with sign ups
targeted for Monday evening. Sign up information to be translated into Spanish as well.
i. Evelyn would like to reserve a certain number of spots for each enrichment ( 3 spots/class) for equity purposes - teachers can hold back \#/spots per class via Six Crickets by notifying Juliette. These spots will be made available to students on a needs basis and coordinated through the district's financial survey data and the office. Therefore, no scholarships will be offered directly through PAF.
