# SRCS Santa Rosa French American Charter School Foundation Parent Association Foundation Meeting Minutes

V. Consent Agenda and Approval of Minutes

Minutes from previous meeting were approved via email and posted to the website/app. Carmen motioned to approve the updated agenda: Sharon seconded the motion. Motion unanimously approved. Agenda approved.
VI. Board Reports
A. PRESIDENT'S REPORT: Ben -Attendance report is not great, yet consistent with district, state results ( $\sim 25 \%$ chronic absenteeism rate) which impacts school funding and students' learning. Independent studies must be requested two weeks in advance and approval is up to the teacher's discretion. Even approved independent studies count against attendance reports. If your child is sick, you need to notify the school daily. Even excused absences (i.e., late for Drs appts) count against attendance reports, which directly affect funding as well as education children receive.
B. PRINCIPAL'S REPORT: Evelyn - Things are going well. Teachers and children are amazing, and things are going well.
C. TREASURER'S REPORT: Sean -About $\$ 242 \mathrm{k}$ in our accounts (Inc the CD in savings at Redwood we recently created). Finalizing everything in the Wells Fargo account to complete transition to Redwood. Tracking along with FamilyGiving, with recurring donations, we
should meet our \$120k goal. Recent Dine\&Donate at Towne was a huge success and Café Citti as well. Carnaval ticket sales coming in...entertainment is reaching budget amount but should even out. Kermese coming up. Classroom supplies and resources are even, 4k from Teacher Wish campaign in there. (Teachers were all thrilled to get their supplies - so thank you!). At Field trip budget so may need to increase that budget. Discussion on pending field trips. Garden budgets remain, discussion around garden spending and perhaps need a message to teachers to encourage taking classes out to the garden. May need a new garden coordinator. Sarah will notify us if we need a replacement, but budget will remain. Action: Sharon/Ludo: message to teachers to utilize garden in their classes.

## VII. Updates, Discussion, and Action Items

A. Action item from budget discussion: Increase in field trip spend this year which includes some spend for $7^{\text {th }} / 8^{\text {th }}$ as well as getting back to pre-Covid levels of field trips. Ben motioned to raise budget for field trips by $\$ 5 \mathrm{k}$. Carmen seconded. Motion unanimously approved.
B. Eloquentia Presentation Update: Ketsia - program that is growing in France, built by a lawyer that wanted to serve students in college from disadvantaged backgrounds teaching them how to debate, communicate, fill with empathy and act in public space. Also supported by actors, in elementary schools from $5^{\text {th }}$ grade on in France and supported by French Ministry of Education. All about development of oral language esp. in foreign language and debate. Group of 3 teachers coming in April (1 at Slater, 2 for $6^{\text {th }}$ grade) for one week. Ketsia went to meeting in Bay area for French schools and all impressed we had them coming, is a really big deal. Now, we need to pay for plane tickets. Hoping to plan a presentation on Friday night (April 26) to inspire, motivate parents and teachers. They need to be lodged, Sunday, April 21 - 27. Action: Emmanuel to touch base with Ketsia wrt housing. Action: All SRFACS community to consider hosting a teacher for one week. If interested, contact Ketsia.
C. Tax Returns: Sean - Price for preparing increased. Sean has reviewed and noted there were no significant changes from previous year and nothing of note to report. Ben motioned to approve tax return, Carmen seconded. Motion unanimously approved. Returns will be sent to Carmen to post on website once completed.
D. Fundraising: Ben, Nora, Jenny- Teachers need to submit receipts to close out on Teacher Wish Campaign. All items delivered.
E. Communications: Carmen, Aimee - Aimee doing a great job on app communications!

K. Enrichment: Juliette, Lauren
a. Spring: Starts April 1 - Juliette needs to meet with Evelyn prior to next schedule going out. If a teacher needs more materials, can request reimbursement from PAF. Action: Evelyn, Juliette and Ben to connect in the next week.
L. Event Czar: Brittany
a. Carnaval: Nora, Jenny, Brittany (Advisor) - As the event nears closer, all PAFers will receive timelines, asks for that day etc. for NOW, wrt auction items, email went out to classes wrt each class item. Currently at about 37 items and we had 60 items last year. All PAFers have spreadsheets; ACTION: all to find more Auction items. We need more experiential type items (cooking classes with wine, food with drinks etc), we also need more wine, champagne donations. 5 live auction items (vs 6 last year). Discussion around extending online auction. No sound gear needed, mic included. Photo Booth planned. 177 tickets sold so far, goal is 250, we had 206 last year. Online ticket sales end February $16^{\text {th }}$. If you buy a table, you have all seats at the table and your table is assigned at the door.
